

Acceptable Use Policy for the Erskine Academy Guest Network

The purpose of this document is to protect users of the guest network, protect the school's main network, and ensure clarity of expectations around the guest network's usage. It accomplishes this by clearly stating expectations and responsibilities of those using the network.

By signing this document I agree to the terms and conditions of this acceptable usage statement. I understand that violation of this agreement will subject me to appropriate disciplinary action as prescribed by Erskine Academy.

- I understand that use of this network is a privilege and not a right.
- A past history of Acceptable Use Policy violations could make me ineligible for this privilege.
- I agree to only connect to the Service Set Identifier for the guest network as defined by the Erskine Academy Director of Technology.
 - I will not set up any other wireless networks (ad hoc or otherwise).
- I understand that the network is an open network (very similar to what you would find in a free wireless area in the general public) and I assume all risks of damage to my machine.
- I will not have any software loaded on my machine that would be used for hacking into other students' computers or the school system.
 - Such software could include (but not limited to): packet sniffers, password crackers, wireless software designed to gain access to others' accounts.
- I will comply with the filtering rules for the network and I will not try in anyway to bypass those rules or show others how to bypass those rules.
- I understand that I can be monitored on this network.
- I will surrender my system at any time to be reviewed for the above rules, whether it is by a random audit or for suspicion of rule violation.
- I understand that I will be responsible for my computer whether I am using it or have loaned it out.
- The Erskine Academy Technology Department will not be responsible for troubleshooting my system in any way (i.e., unable to connect to the network, hardware or software issues with your computer).
- The "guest network" will be a secondary priority to the school's network. Issues with the school's main network will take precedence over the guest network.
