

News from the Erskine Academy Cafeteria:

Dear Parents,

Beginning in mid-December, “storm pack meals” will be available (at no charge to all students). These meals are intended to be stored for the event there is a snow day that would constitute as a remote learning day. This will be based on a decision made by the administration.

THIS FORM MUST BE TURNED IN TO HOMEROOM TEACHERS or THE CAFETERIA no later than December 4<sup>th</sup> to allow us to plan ahead. We do not need the name of your student, just a head count. For remote learners, please only send a correspondence if you choose “yes” below. You may email Stacy, or mail back your response.

“Storm pack meals” will come frozen, including milk in cartons. Milk has a short shelf life but has a long shelf life when frozen. Milk from a frozen state is safe to drink once thawed under refrigeration past an expiration date. Reheating directions will come with the meals. Distribution of storm packs will be made at school, and students can pick them up at the end of the day before leaving.

**For remote learners, storm packs can be picked up at school between 7am and 2pm on Wednesday Dec. 9<sup>th</sup> in the cafeteria.**

All storm day meal packs should be discarded if not consumed by March 31 2021. In the event the school declares a storm day as a remote educational learning day, a notification will be sent out. If storm packs are used, we will redistribute new packs as needed.
