Scholarship Application

One scholarship of \$500 renewable up to four years for a total of \$2,000 will be awarded to a student from one of the high schools noted below. The winner will be notified by their Guidance Office. In order to receive their award, each year the student must: 1) provide evidence of having successfully completed the first semester as a full-time student in good standing at an accredited college, university, or technical school (passing grades in all subjects); and 2) provide evidence of enrollment as a full-time student for a second semester of post secondary school.

A further condition of this scholarship is that the second semester referenced above must begin within a year of the first semester.

Eligibility requirements are as follows:

1. Be a graduating senior from central Maine.
2. Acceptance to an accredited college, university, or technical school.
3. Demonstration of financial need.
4. Demonstrate passing grades in all subjects during your high school years.
5. Participation in community service.
